

<p><b>Role 1: Biologist</b></p> <p><b>Main Goal:</b> To reintroduce condors back to San Pedro Matir in central Baja.</p> <p><b>Daily Activities:</b> Prepare condors for release to the wild. Care for condors in pens and feed each day. Release birds when they have acclimated to the site. Attach tags to the birds that allow radio tracking of their movements. Track condors using visual sighting and radio tracking. Talk to people about the important of condors in the natural environment.</p> <p><b>Major Emotion:</b> Feels condors should be reintroduced and protected.</p>	<p><b>Role 2: Farmer</b></p> <p><b>Main Goal:</b> To plant, harvest and sell crops to provide for his/her own family.</p> <p><b>Activities:</b> Plant, harvest, and sell, different crops. Talk with neighbors about the crops and other people's gardening efforts. Plays with his or her children.</p> <p><b>Major Emotion:</b> Afraid the reintroduction of the condor will affect his or her ability to feed their family. There may be more regulation on the land and how it is used. The birds may cause damage to his/her crops.</p>
<p><b>Role 3: Tourist</b></p> <p><b>Main Objective:</b> TO see a wild condor.</p> <p><b>Activities:</b> Drives to San Pedro Martir. Talks to anyone he or she can about whether they have seen a condor and where. Asks directions for finding their way. Buys food at the local store and has a room at a local hotel. Takes lots of photographs. Talks about the beauty of the condor.</p> <p><b>Major Emotion:</b> Wants to see condors. Is not very interested in people.</p>	<p><b>Role 4: Hunter</b></p> <p><b>Main Objective:</b> To shoot a deer in the San Pedro de Matir.</p> <p><b>Activities:</b> Drives and hikes roads of San Pedro Matir looking for deer. Uses binoculars to try and spot deer. Sometimes get to shoot deer. Uses deer meat to feed family and enjoys the hunting experience.</p> <p><b>Major Emotion:</b> Concern that bringing condors back into the National Park will limit his ability to hunt in the area.</p>
<p><b>Role 5: Native People</b></p> <p><b>Main Objective:</b> To tell the story of the past relationship to the condor.</p> <p><b>Activities:</b> Tell the story of his/her people and their relationship to the land. Talk about the important of the condor to his tribe.</p> <p><b>Major Emotion:</b> Deep respect for the condor.</p>	<p><b>Role 6: California Condor</b></p> <p><b>Main Objective:</b> To fly, find food, and mate.</p> <p><b>Activities:</b> Flying from the mountains to the sea. Looking for and eating animal carcasses. Watching out for golden eagles. Avoiding humans.</p>
